

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting of the King George Republican Committee
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the King George Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Larry B. Kile, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the King George County Citizens Center, 8076 Kings Highway, King George, VA 22485, starting at 7:00pm local time on March 3, 2009, for the following purposes:

1. Electing up to 170 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to cast 34 votes at the 2009 State Convention, to be held on May 29-30, 2009 at the Greater Richmond Convention Center, 403 North Third Street, Richmond, VA, 23219, beginning at 2:00pm local time on Friday, May 29, 2009, for the following purposes:
 - a. Nominating a Republican candidate for Governor, Lieutenant Governor and Attorney General, to be elected November 3, 2009;
 - b. Any other business as may properly come before the Convention.

Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the King George Republican Committee is entitled to 34 Delegate Votes.

2. Electing up to 170 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to cast 34 votes at 99th Legislative District Convention, to be held on May 16, 2009 at the A.T. Johnson Human Services Building, 18849 Kings Highway (Route 3), Montross, VA 22520, beginning at 10:30am, for the following purposes:
 - a. Nominating a Republican candidate to serve as a member of the House of Delegates representing the 99th Legislative District of Virginia to be elected November 3, 2009;
 - b. Any other business as may properly come before the Convention.

Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the King George Republican Committee is entitled to 34 Delegate votes.

3. Any other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of King George County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing, as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party after March 1, 2004, or in the last five years, whichever is more recent.

A single exception to this shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of this exception thereafter.

Voters may be required to produce personal identification such as a valid driver's license or voter registration card.

Registration Fee

There will be no registration fee required to participate in this mass meeting, but a voluntary contribution of \$10 per participant is requested. There is a voluntary registration fee of \$35 for the State Convention and \$10 for the District Convention.

Mass Meeting Registration

Registration to participate in the Mass Meeting will begin no sooner than 5:45pm local time and end no earlier than 6:45pm local time. Registration time may be extended at the direction of the Chairman. All persons in line at 6:45pm local time will be allowed to register. Proxies will not be allowed.

Candidate Pre-File Requirements

All candidates for 2009 State Convention Delegate and/or 99th House District Convention Delegate are required to pre-file their intentions by completely and properly submitting the Delegate Pre-Registration Form for the King George March 2009 Mass Meeting indicating the Delegate position(s) being sought by mail, to the King George Republican Committee, Post Office Box 221, King George, VA 22485, which MUST be received not later than 5:00pm local time Friday, February 27, 2009. Post-marks do not govern. Applications will also be accepted in person to Larry Kile at 9595 Mohawk Dr, King George, VA 22485 or Darryl Breitenstein at 11279 Ridge Rd, King George, VA 22485 prior to 5:00pm local time Friday, February 27, 2009.
